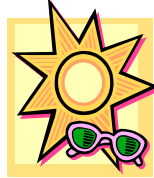

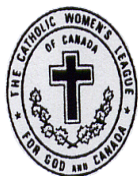

## Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

**First Reading: Proverbs 9:1-6**  
*Come, eat of my bread and drink of the wine  
I have mixed.*

**Second Reading: Ephesians 5:15-20**  
*Understand what the will of the Lord is.*

**Gospel: John 6:51-58**  
*My flesh is true food and my blood is true  
drink.*

We delve deeper and deeper in the  
Eucharistic mystery, “How can this man  
give us his flesh to eat?” the people ask  
(John 6:52). The word *flesh* scares them.  
Spirit is spirit, and flesh is flesh; Jesus  
seems to be mixing up the two. Jesus  
does not back down. Instead, he  
insistently repeats the words *flesh* and  
*blood, eat and drink* (6:54-56). This kind  
of eating and drinking leads to spiritual  
results. The one who eats this bread has  
“life” (6:53), then “eternal life,” (6:54).  
They will share in the resurrection on  
the “last day” (6:54—an abiding life in  
Jesus himself, a life which comes from  
the Father). Like Wisdom in the first  
reading today, Jesus issues an invitation  
to a banquet. We are free to accept or  
refuse.
