

# Family Page

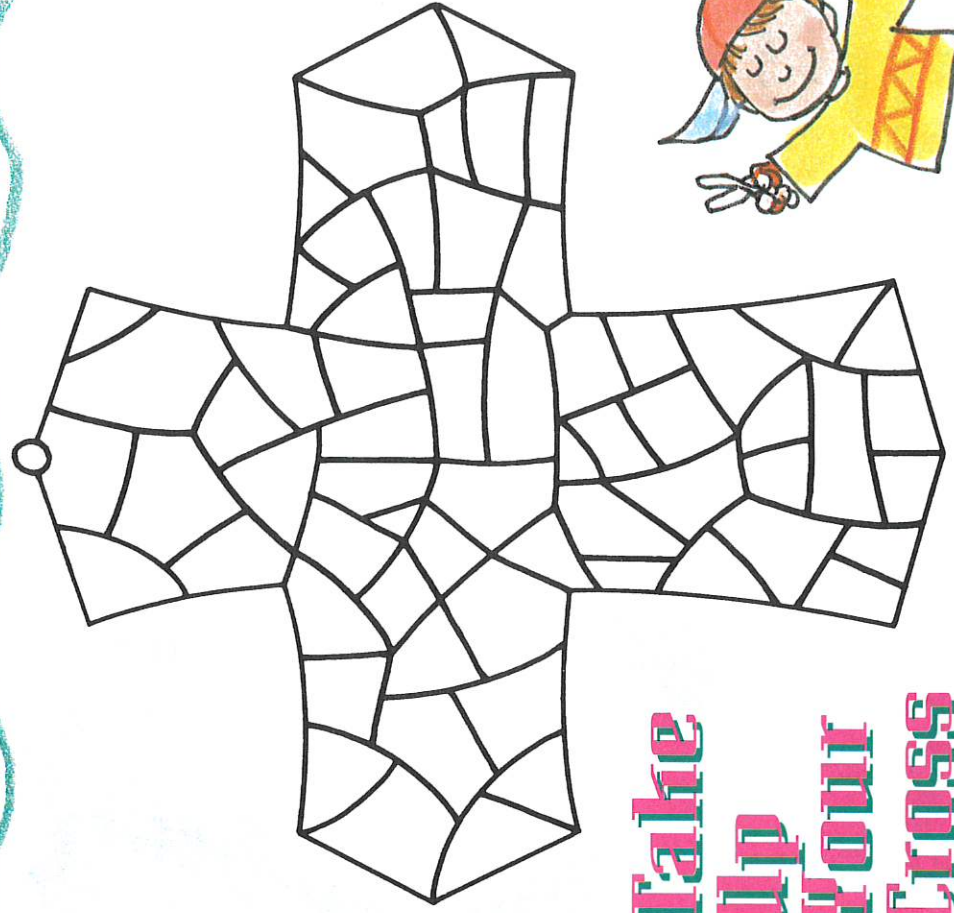
Follow these steps for a family project this week that will help you remember to choose the Jesus way.

- 1** Talk about people who have made love-choices to follow Jesus even though it meant their lives would be very hard: Mother Teresa, Archbishop Oscar Romero, missionaries, and so forth. Emphasize especially people you know who are always helping others.
- 2** Talk about love-choices you can make, for example, helping at home, sharing with friends, visiting an elderly relative or neighbor, or writing a letter to grandparents.
- 3** Trace the cross on the front of this bulletin as many times as necessary to make one for each family member.
- 4** Now, every time one of the family makes a love-choice this week, he or she can color in another section of the cross, using a variety of bright colors.
- 5** When the crosses are all filled in, hang them in a prominent place to remind yourselves to continue to follow Jesus.

In today's gospel story, Jesus says to his disciples, "You must take up your cross and begin to follow in my footsteps."

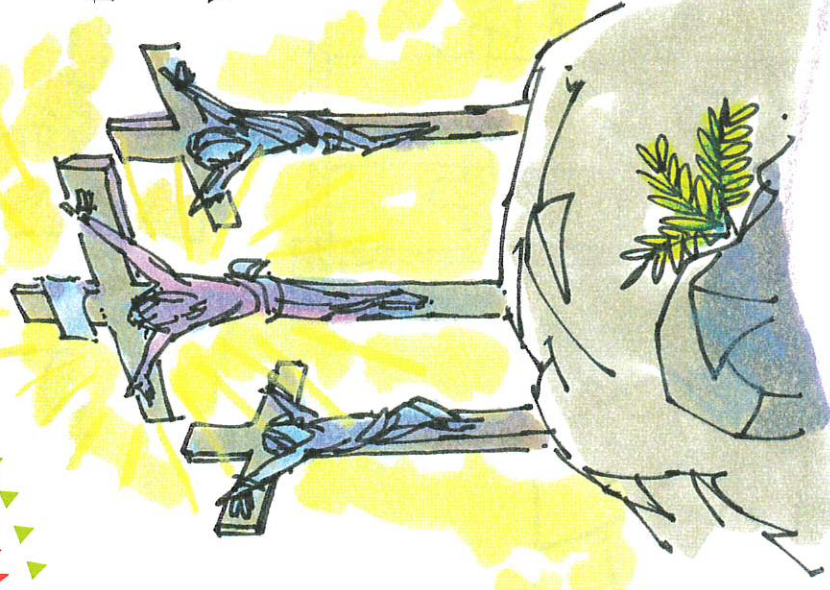
Jesus had choices to make in his life. He chose to suffer and die on the cross so we could go to heaven. It was a love-choice, a Jesus-choice.
