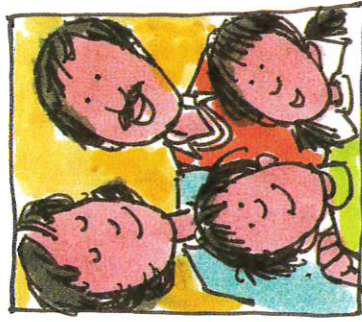


Family Page
