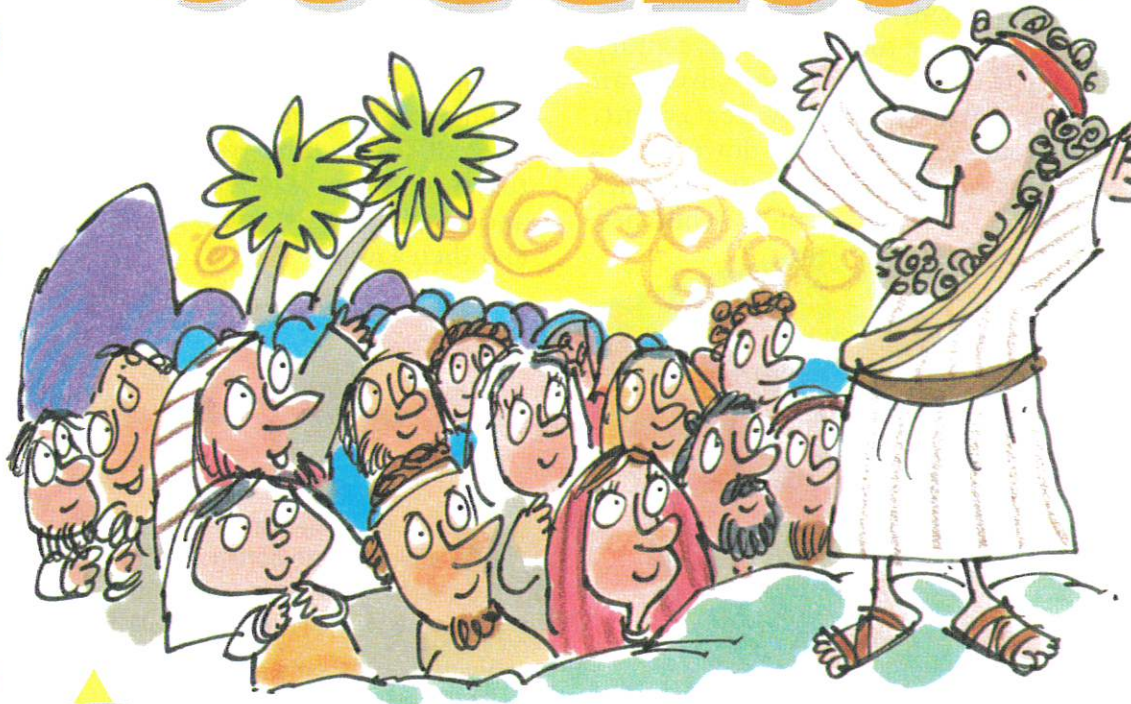


# THE SECRET OF SUCCESS
